



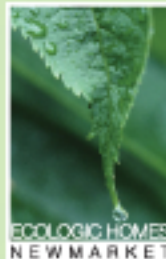

LEED® Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design® is a world-wide sustainable building rating system that was developed and operated by the building community through the various Green Building Councils throughout the world. The process was open, consensus-based and made up entirely of volunteers. LEED's mandate is to encourage and accelerate the global adoption of sustainable green building and development practices through the creation and implementation of universally understood and accepted tools and performance criteria. The Canada Green Building Council has set a target of influencing 1 million green homes by 2030.

LEED-H for Homes is a new label for the Canadian Housing market that rates more than just your home's energy consumption. LEED-H assesses the environmental impact of the construction and the operation of a home, everything from occupant health to how far material had to travel to get to the site is considered. Holistic in its environmental approach, LEED-H bring a broader level of assessment and comparison which raises the bar for the building industry beyond anything else that is in the marketplace.
